Tuition and Fees

Application Fee:

A \$50.00 (non-refundable) fee is due upon applying.

Tuition:

The annual tuition of \$5,100.00 is due on or before August 19, 2023.

Early Tuition Payment:

- A tuition reduction of 10% is granted to students that pay the full year's tuition by July 28, 2023.
 - Example: \$5,100.00 - \$510.00 (10%) = \$4,590.00 early tuition payment discount

Optional 4-Payment Plan:

The payment plan consists of 4 payments of \$1,275.00. Two payments are due in the first semester and the last two payments are due in the second semester.

In the event the student is approved for the payment plan, the following payments must be submitted on or before their due date:

- First payment of \$1,275.00 is due before the first day of school - no later than August 25, 2023
- Second payment of \$1,275.00 is due no later than October 13, 2023
- Third payment of \$1,275.00 is due no later than January 12, 2024
- Fourth payment of \$1,275.00 is due no later than March 8, 2024

Fee for the payment plan is \$75.00.

Late payment fee is \$50.00.

Deposit Fee:

A \$250.00 reservation deposit fee is due after your application has been fully accepted. This fee will be deducted from your total tuition. The fee is required to secure your enrollment and reserve your seat in the upcoming school term at the Nations College.

Additional Fees: \$300.00 per year (approximately) for such items as books, fees, etc.

Reservation Deposit and Enrollment: Incoming Freshmen submit deposit and enroll by May 1st, 2023.

Admission Requirements

General Requirements for Admission¹:

1. Proof of secondary education, which may include:
 - a. An **official** completed high school, GED transcript (or equivalent), or an official transcript from your highest level of completed education.
 - b. Homeschooled applicants must submit a high school transcript and a letter from the student's respective Superintendent of Schools (or comparable chief school administrator) certifying that the student has completed the substantial equivalent of a four-year high school course.
2. Applicants must be connected to a local church. A Senior Pastor or other church leader reference will be requested at the discretion of the Admissions Director or Admissions Committee.

If you are currently attending high school, you may request an in-progress transcript be sent to us for admission evaluation, followed by a final, official transcript upon graduation. An official transcript is sent directly to Nations College from the high school.

If you are currently enrolled in a college or university, submit an unofficial transcript for preliminary evaluation, followed by a final, official transcript once you receive your final grades. An official transcript is sent directly to Nations College from the college or university.

A Complete Application Includes:

1. Admission application.
2. Application fee (the \$50 application fee is calculated into the annual tuition and fees).
3. Complete the online orientation (required for both on-campus and online students).
4. Complete the High School Self-Certification form (located on the application).
 - **NOTE:** An official high school or GED transcript (or your highest completed level/degree) is required within the first 12 credit hours of classes.
5. Completed *Christian Testimony* (located on the application).
6. Completed *Pastoral Reference Form* from your pastor.
7. Completed *General Reference Form* from a friend or colleague (not a family member).
8. Upon being accepted, a reservation deposit fee of \$250.00 is required to secure your enrollment (this fee will be deducted from your total tuition).

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International Students:

We are unable to accept international students for the **on-campus** Associate of Arts in Practical Ministry degree program until the **Fall of 2025** (projected date).
